

TRAVERSE CITY WINE TRAIL AND BREWERY 2 DAY BIKE TOUR



Experience Michigan's premier beer and wine country by bike! Great for all abilities

This unique 2 day casual cycling package will experience the wineries just off the Leelanau Trail and cycle through historic Traverse City to areas best breweries.

DAY ONE: Start in Suttons Bay and follow the Leelanau Trail as it meanders through the orchards and vineyards visiting 4 different wineries. Mid-day we will enjoy a gourmet picnic overlooking the vineyards. For the day we will cycle about 15 miles at a casual pace on a paved trail and quiet back roads.

DAY TWO: We will cycle through the historic downtown of Traverse City staying on side-roads and paved trails. After a history tour of the downtown we will cycle to 2 different breweries where you can taste beers with locally grown hops and learn about the different artisan styles. We will enjoy a pub style lunch of wood-oven pizzas overlooking the Boardman Lake. We will cycle about 10 miles at a casual pace, with stops along the way.

What's Included: Bike & helmet rental, knowledgeable local guide, gourmet lunches, snacks & water, van support (wine purchase pickup!), roadside assistance, souvenir water bottle. *Special dietary needs can be met.

Other Notes: Responsible for own lodging. We will provide you with recommendations to our favorite Traverse City hotels and restaurants, so you will be in good hands. Tasting fees are not included.
